



## Oxford Green Week (8-16 June 2019)

### One Planet Living Photo Competition – Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is open to residents of Oxfordshire from age 5 years or over, except for employees of Bioregional, their families or anyone else associated with this competition.
2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Entries should be submitted by the designated google form:  
<https://goo.gl/forms/34jjEOtePuVDpsW43>. Image files must be 200 dpi and between 1MB and 3MB. File format must be either JPEG or TIFF. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.
4. All entries must be received by the advertised closing time and date: midnight on June 9, 2019.
5. All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them with the exception of a parent/guardian submitting a photo for an entrant in the child category. The image must not have been published elsewhere or have won a prize in any other photographic competition.
6. This is an amateur photography competition. We therefore request that in the spirit of the competition, professional photographers do not submit any entries.
7. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.

8. Copyright in all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their submitting an image to the Competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to Bioregional to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition.

9. Entrants are allowed to submit up to 3 images. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt. Entries must not be sent through agencies or third parties.

10. The winning entry will be judged by a panel consisting of Bioregional and Oxford City Council. The winner will be notified within seven days of the closing date of the competition. The winner is required to be in contact with Bioregional within 24 hours of Bioregional contacting them; otherwise, another winner will be chosen.

11. Entries must not be drastically edited in a way that alters the reality of the image (e.g. through using Photoshop software or similar). The image should be from a single photo where items in the photo are not added or removed. Basic alterations of colour and light using the camera or smart phone on which the image was taken are permissible.

12. One adult entrant shall win 2 tickets for a Renault Twizy electric car tour around the Blenheim Palace grounds worth approximately £70.00 plus a small selection of locally sourced food worth approximately £30.00. One child entrant shall win paid adoption/sponsorship of a vulnerable animal of their choice worth approximately £50.00 and a small selection of Fairtrade, sustainable products worth approximately £10.00. Winners' photographs will also be displayed at Bioregional's 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary photography exhibition held at Feilden Clegg Bradley's offices throughout the month of July.

13. The vouchers for the prizes cannot be exchanged for cash. Lost or stolen vouchers cannot be refunded.



14. The winners may be required to take part in publicity, and will be invited to receive their prize at the One Planet Oxfordshire celebration event on the evening of June 11<sup>th</sup>.

15. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication. All prizes are non-transferable and there are no cash alternatives.

16. Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter and accordingly the Promoter may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.

17. Bioregional is responsible for the promotion, which is the publication and adjudication of the competition, and all other facilities connected with the provision of the prize.
